

(International premiere) by Jakob Krese and Danilo do Carmo, which outlines the immigrant drama though the story of a young mother and her four children, who set out for the dangerous journey from Guatemala to the United States.

Curtain call for the competition sections of the 24th TDF with >>Film Forward Competition, where *Amateur* (world premiere) of the Spanish filmmaker Martín Gutiérrez binds together three seemingly unrelated stories, weaving an intimate and personal homeland. In *Anachronic Chronicles: Voyages Inside/Out Asia* (European premiere) by Lu Pan and Yu Araki, we are given an insight into how the launching and the wide use of the video camera radically changed the everyday life, but also the way family memories are recorded for almost every household in the Far East.

Dreams of the Sky Mausoleum (international premiere) by Russian Marianna Rybynok contemplates on the notion of body, that balances between a refuge and a prison. In *Film Is Dead* (world premiere) by Argentinian Juan Benitez Allassia, abandoned movie theaters in the director's hometown are transformed into a living monument of time, loss and shattering changes. Dutch director Oeke Hoogendijk, in *Housewitz* (international premiere) turns the camera towards her mother and converses with the Holocaust ghosts, in a quirky story of reclusion and isolation.

In *Pobo "Tzu" – White Night* (European premiere) by Tania Ximena and Yolloti Manuel Gómez Alvarado from Mexico, poetry and nature and interweaved in a ritual as old as time, while *Sorrow Tamers* (international premiere) by Finnish Mina Laamo is ruminating on the indiscernible layers of sorrow and grief. *The Bride* (international premiere) by Samira Guadagnuolo and Tiziano Doria offers a taste of the mystic traditions and the ancestral spiritual legacy of the Italian south. Finally, we call it a wrap with the documentary *The Invitation* (world premiere) by Fabrizio Maltese that invites us to a poetic encounter between two top-notch filmmakers, Abderrahmane Sissako and recently deceased Pol Cruchten, which transcends the irrevocability of death.







>>FILM FORWARD COMPETITION AWARDS

The Golden Alexander >>Film Forward Award (€6,000 cash prize): *The Bride* by Samira Guadagnuolo & Tiziano Doria (Italy). Citation: A film that, with minimal yet powerful and precise cinematic means, tells an important story of how patriarchal societies repress women. The award unanimously goes to the striking film where silence speaks louder than voice.

The >>Film Forward Award Special Jury Prize (€3,000 cash prize) was awarded ex æquo to the documentaries: *Amateur* by Martín Gutiérrez (Spain) & *Letter to Nikola* by Hara Kaminara (Greece-Belgium). Citation: For *Letter to Nikola*, we give the award for its striking visual language and the filmmaker's moving treatment of motherhood in turbulent times. For *Amateur* we give the award for its charming, and tender amateur look that unites three different stories in one landscape".

The Podcast Award (€2,000 cash prize): *Forever* by Dimitris Daskas (Greece)

Special Mention: *Invisible* by Marianna Kakaounaki (Greece)

Louis Lumière Award/Scholarship: Nepheli Sani for the podcast *Sonic Memorabilia*

Mermaid Award for the best LGBTQI+-themed film from the Festival's official selection: *Gabi: Between Ages 8 and 13* (Sweden-Norway). Citation: "A beautifully subtle expression of the need for acceptance of oneself as a whole human being, this film is a playful exploration of the struggles of growth, love and identity. The freedom in defying conventional binary norms is adeptly presented, and the importance of agency for self-determination is uniquely expressed in the form of a perfectly imperfect child and her fami

ly and friends. [Awarded] for its inspiringly joyful portrayal of gender fluidity and the powerful example it sets for families of non-cisgender children. Special Mentions: *Mel* by Inna Sahakyan & Paul Cohen (Armenia-The Netherlands) & *Sirens* by Rita Baghdadi (USA-Lebanon)

Human Values Award of the Hellenic Parliament: *Eternal Spring* by Jason Loftus (Canada). Citation: A Newcomers Competition film that skillfully binds together personal testimonies and 3D animation to unfold a breathtaking story of a struggle for freedom of ideas and expression against an authoritarian regime that violently

VERDICT: An often poetic and fragmentary course on what it means to be a woman, Tiziano Doria and Samira Guadagnuolo's The Bride is a demanding project that resists conventional storytelling and yet manages to be engaging.





